

THINGS TO KNOW

Rides on the CTA are \$2.25. Multiple and single-ride cards can be purchased at most stations, or at Currency Exchange and Jewel-Osco locations.

O'Hare International Airport is located northwest of downtown, just off of I-90 and I-294. It is also accessible on the Blue Line train.

Midway Airport is located southwest of downtown, off of I-55. It is also accessible on the Orange Line train.

Union Station is located west of RU on Canal Street, between Adams and Jackson. Union Station is the hub for Metra trains, Amtrak, and most longdistance bus services.

The parking lot across from RU on Congress offers validation and is one of the most affordable options for parking downtown. Other lots are located west of Michigan Avenue, and metered street parking is available with a 2-hour time limit.

Traveling north on Michigan Avenue, you will reach Millennium Park, the Bean, the Wrigley Building, and the shops of the Magnificent Mile and Water Tower Mall. Traveling north on State Street will lead you through the Theatre District as well as to many more shopping opportunities.

Remember: If the Lake is on your right, you're traveling north!
